Letter of W., vicar of Epsom and dean of Ewell, concerning the church of Morden.

Pateat universis per presentes quod (1)/

Be it known to all by these presents that

nos W vicarius de Ebesham et Decanus de Ewelle (2)/

we, W., vicar of Epsom and dean of Ewell,

die lune proxima ante festum omnium sanctorum, anno domini millesimo ccc primo, dominum abbatem (3)/
on the Monday next before the feast of All Saints, AD 1301, have fully inducted the lord abbot

Westmonasterii et eiusdem loci conventum per fratrem Walterum de Arkesdene predicti (4)/
of Westminster and the convent of the same place, by brother Walter of Arkesdene of the aforesaid

monasterii, commonachum procuratorem eorumdem in corporalem possessionem ecclesie (5)/
monastery, fellow monk, proctor of the same, into corporal possession of the church

de Mordon cum omnibus juribus et pertinenciis suis per litteram domini J dei gratia Winton (6)/
of Morden with all its rights and appurtenances according to the letter of the lord J., by grace of God,

episcopi plenarie induximus. In cuius rei testimonium presentibus sigillum dicti Decanatus (7)/
bishop of Winchester. In testament of which matter, the seal of the said deanery

de Ewelle est appensum. Datum apud Mordon die et anno supradictis.
