namely that if the aforesaid John Holt pays or causes to be paid [*soluat aut solim fac*'] to the aforesaid Thomas Carter, his heirs and assigns or his named attorney [*aut suo c'to attornat*'] eight pounds sterling in the following manner and form [*modo & forma sequent*'], namely at the next Michaelmas after the date of this court four pounds sterling, part of the said eight pounds, and at the next Michaelmas immediately following four pounds sterling, the rest of the said eight pounds, that then the present [tenant]^{‡‡‡‡‡} shall surrender all his power permanently and effectively.
