



Expenses concerning the fruits of the church of Morden entered in the year 17 Edward II.*

In expenses of 1 carter, 1 stacker, ^{and the same [being] cook} 2 collectors, ~~400k~~ for 6 weeks in harvest 30s.^{25s} In gloves [cerotecis] for the same 7d.^{6d} In gloves given to men of the vill 2s. In stipend of 1 stacker ^{and the same [being] cook} 3s. In stipend of 2 collectors, ~~400k~~ 4s. In payment to the carter for his cart 11s. In wax bought for candles 18d.^{12d} In candles bought 4d.^{2d} this year

Sum 52s 5d.

Sum 46s 8d. Which is joined with the surplus of the account for the manor of Morden for year 17.†

* As the previous account, on membrane 12, ended in July 1323, at the end of 16 Edward II, the harvest expenses for the accounting year are here accounted for in a separate account, for the beginning of 17 Edward II.
