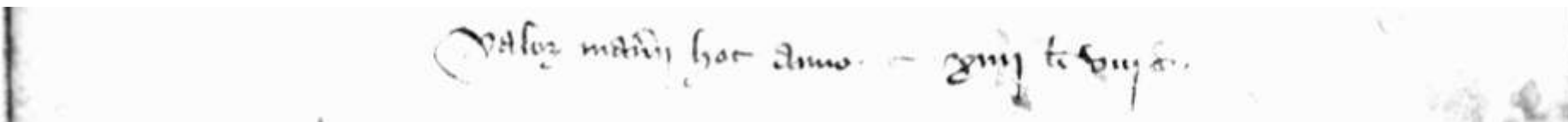


**Sum of allowances and deliveries £13 8s.**

And so he owes 113s 8d. Which arrears, however, will be charged in his account for the following year.

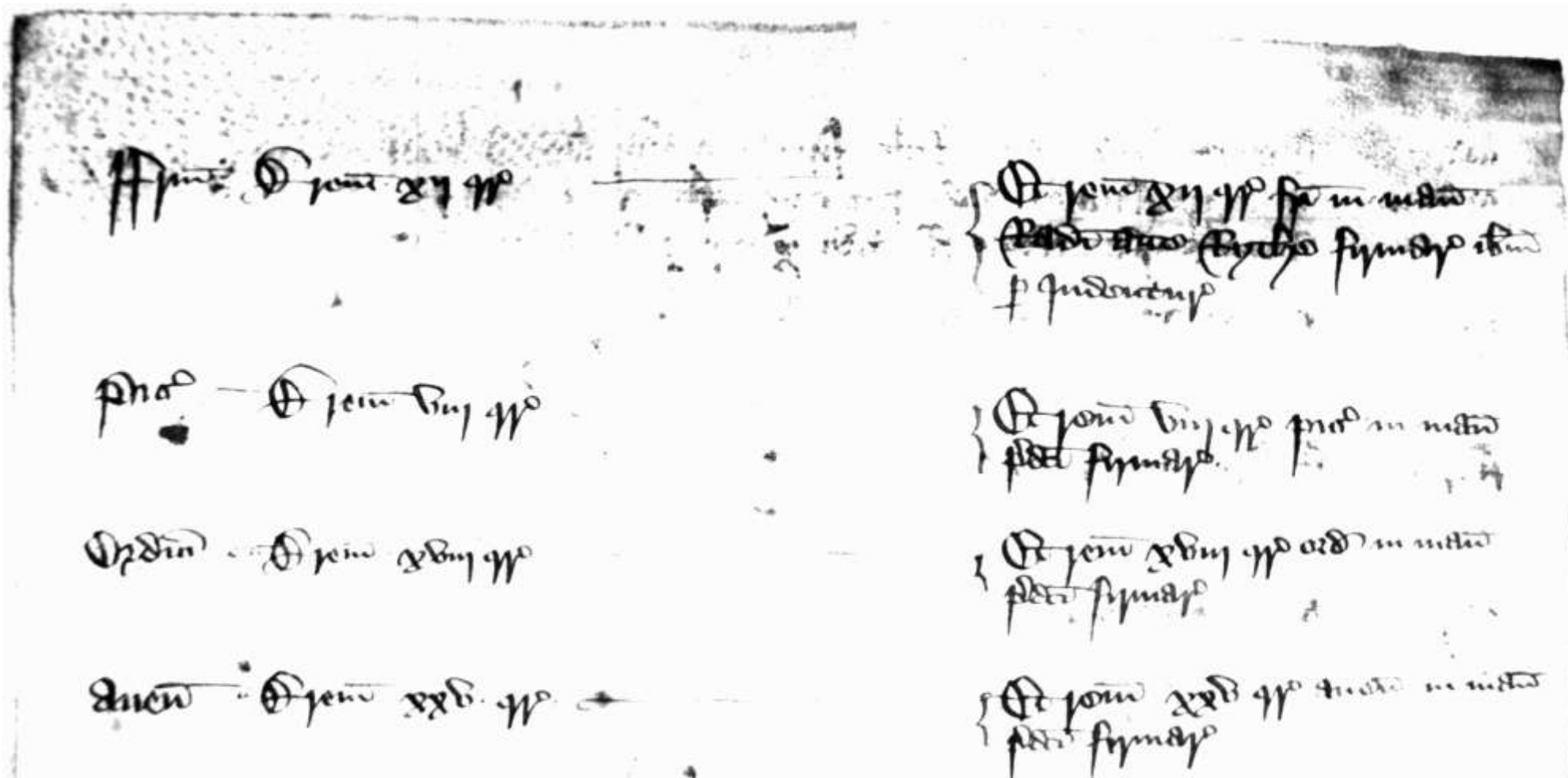

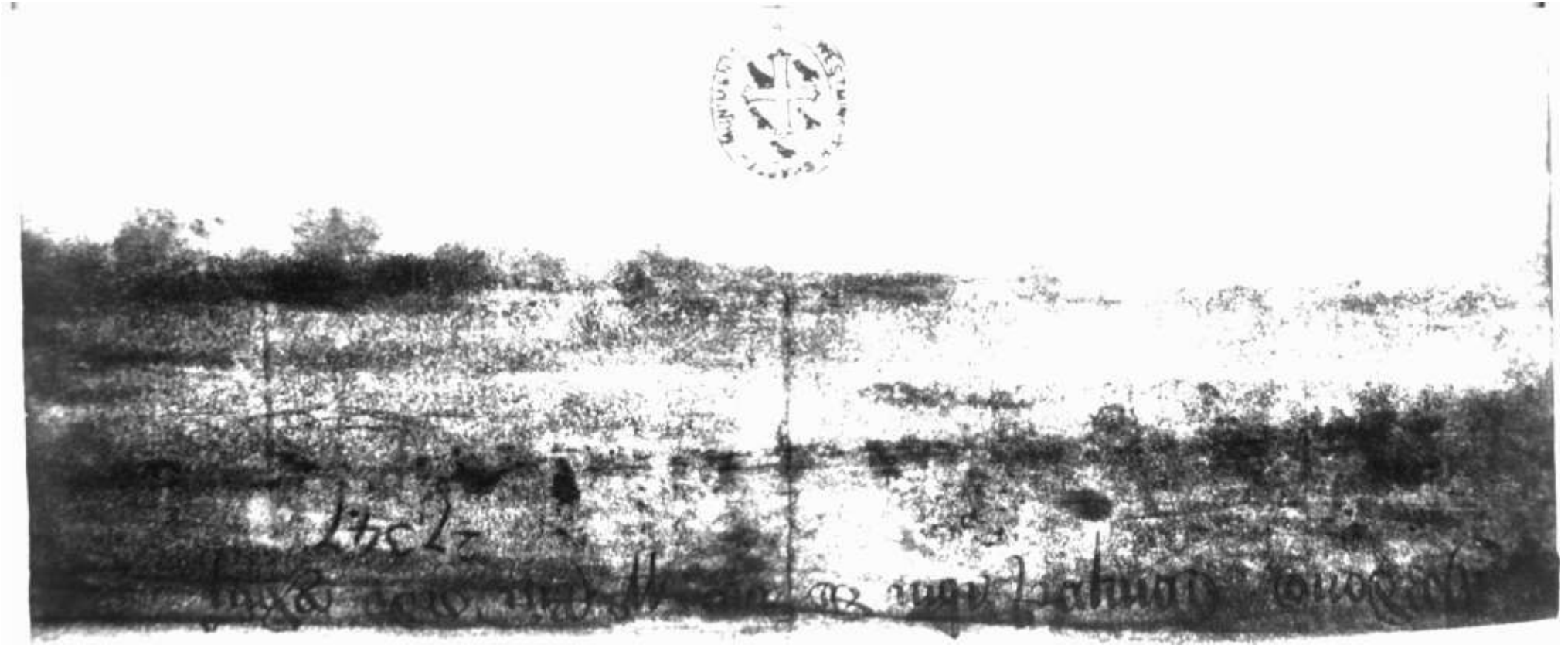
