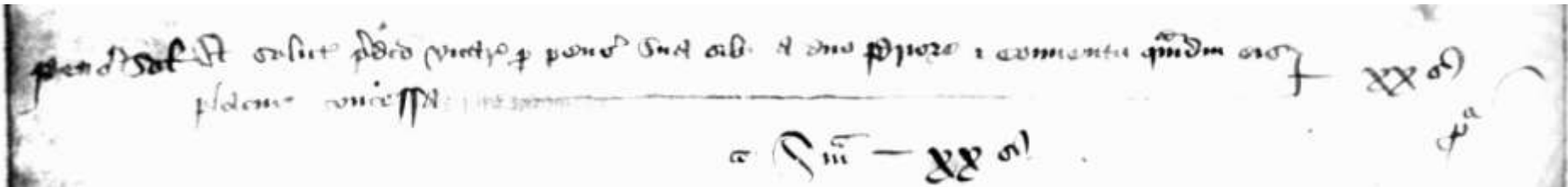




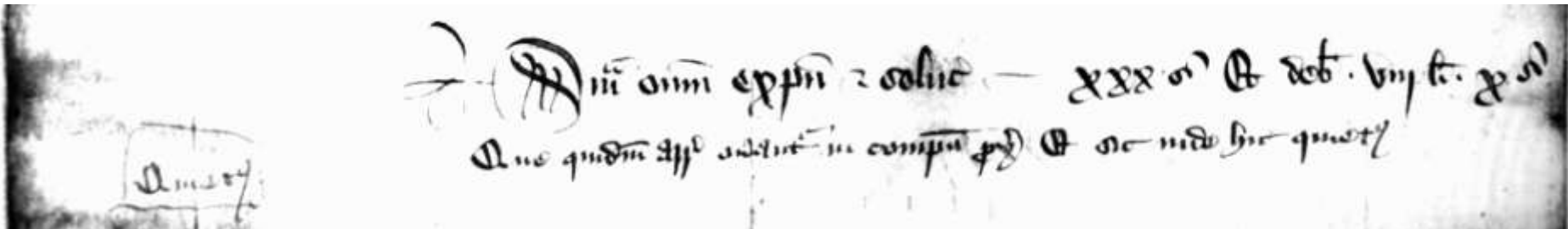
Corn bought

Pension paid

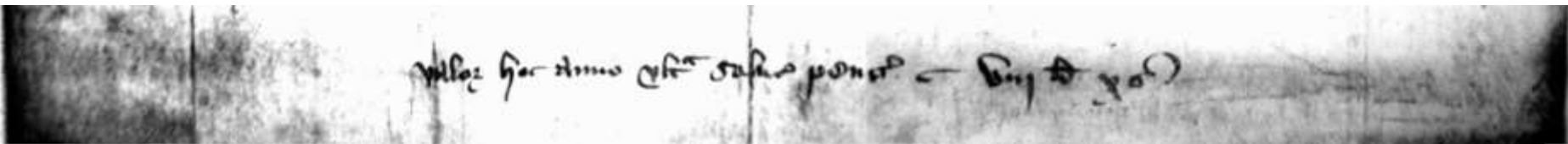
And paid to the aforesaid Vicar for his pension granted to him by the lord Prior and convent as long as it pleases the same 20s. Sum 20s. approved.

Quietus

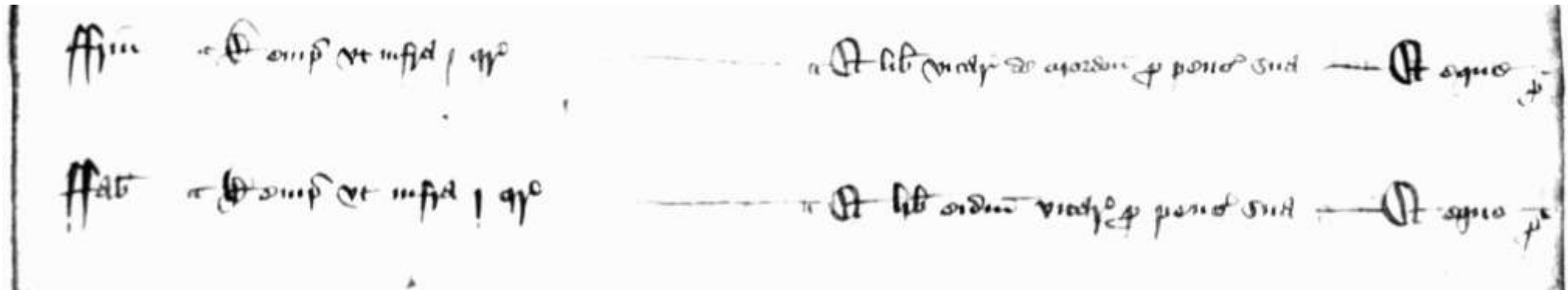
Which arrears, however, will be charged in the next account. And so he is quit in respect of this.
