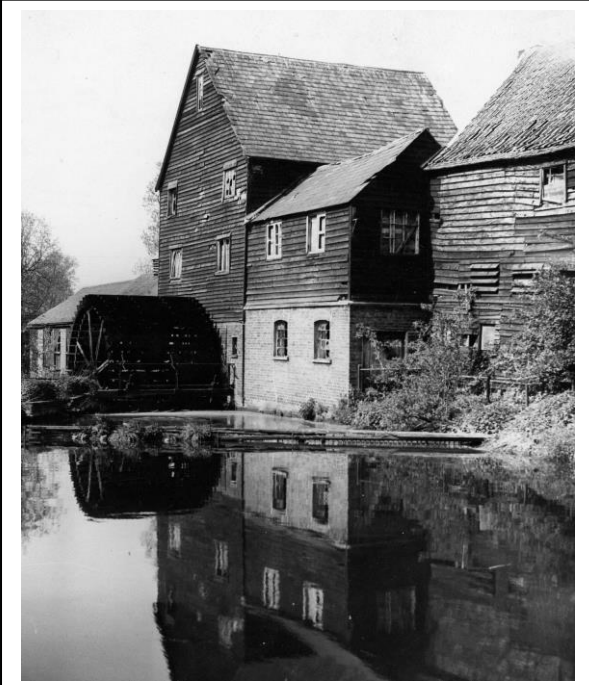


# The Mills of the River Wandle.
