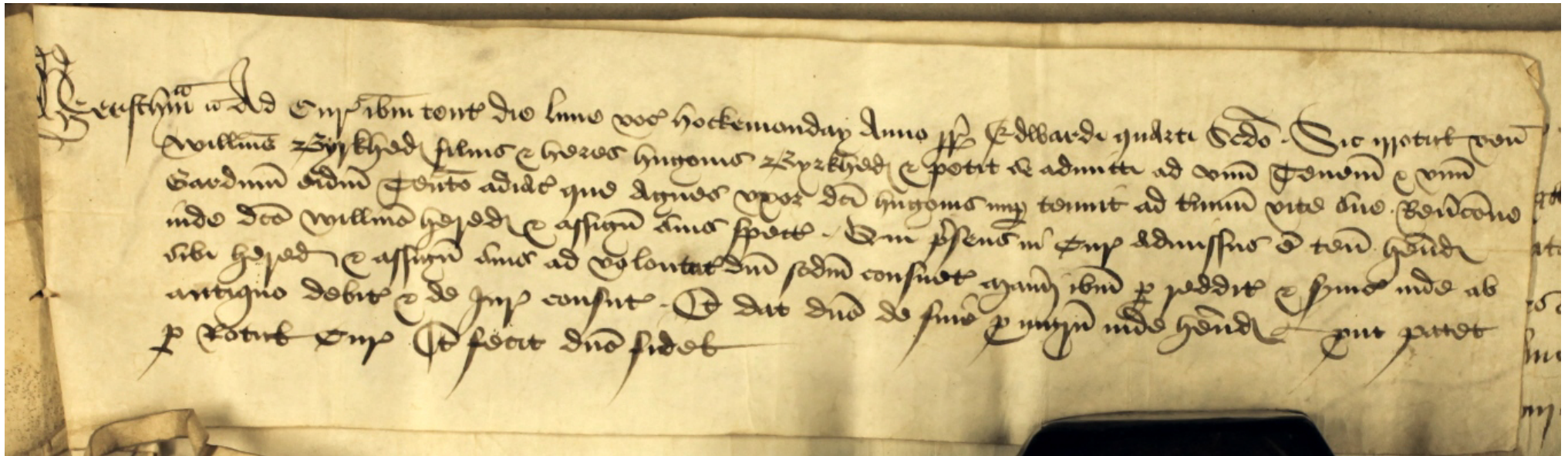


1: William Byrkhed admitted to tenement and garden adjoining

Merstham: At the court held there the Monday called Hock Monday [*Hockemonday*] 2 Ed IV [26.4.1462], so it is enrolled, comes William Byrkhed son and heir of Hugh Byrkhed, and seeks his admittance to one tenement and one garden adjoining the same tenement which Agnes wife of the said Hugh Byrkhed lately held for the term of her life, the reversion thereof belonging to the said William, his heirs and assigns, who being present in court is admitted tenant thereof, to have to himself, his heirs and assigns, at the will of the lord according to the customs of the manor there by the rents and services in respect thereof of old due and customary by law. And he gives the lord for fine for having entry therein as appears by court roll, and he does the lord fealty.
