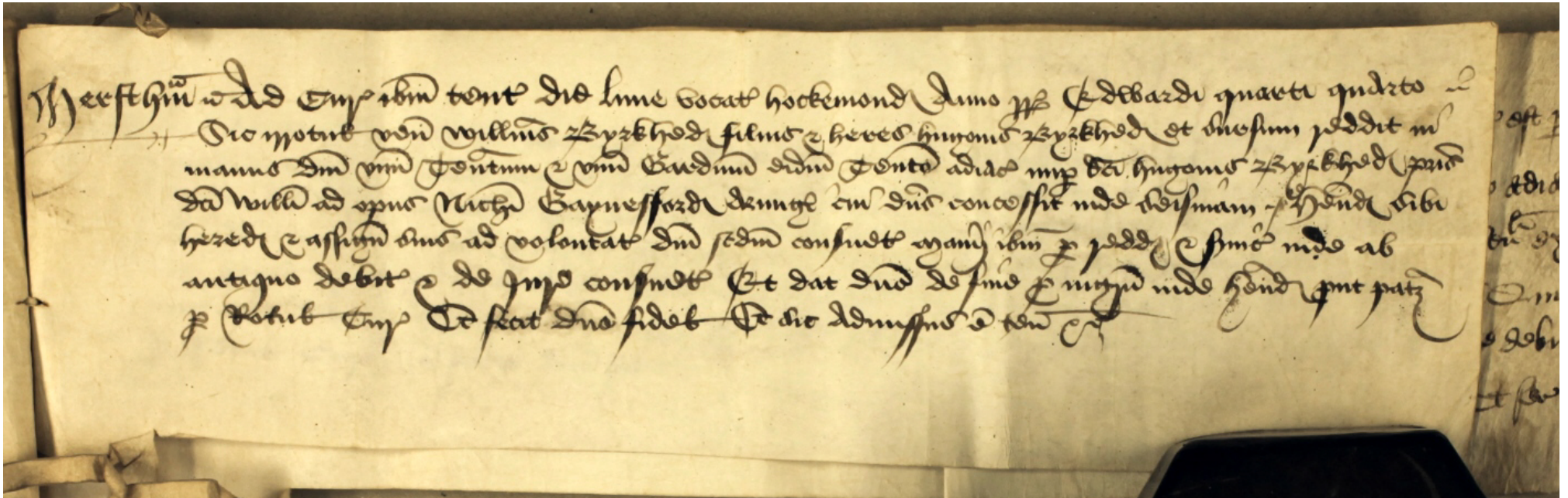


2: William Byrkhed to Nicholas Gaynesford: tenement and garden adjoining

Merstham: At the court held there the Monday called Hock Monday [*Hockemond*] 4 Ed IV, so it is enrolled, comes William Byrkhed son and heir of Hugh Byrkhed, and surrenders into the lord's hand one tenement and one garden adjoining the same tenement late the said Hugh Byrkhed father of the said William, to the use of Nicholas Gaynesford esq, to whom the lord grants seisin thereof, to have to himself, his heirs and assigns, at the will of the lord according to the customs of the manor there by the rents and services in respect thereof of old due and customary by law. And he gives the lord for fine for having entry therein as appears by court roll, and he does the lord fealty and so he is admitted tenant thereof, etc.
