## **EXPENSES**

### **Harvest costs**

Also in expenses of 7<sup>6</sup> men in harvest, viz. 1 rider [*equitator*], 2<sup>1</sup> tithe collector, 1 carter, 1 pitcher, 1 stacker both at the manor and at the rectory and 1 cellarer [*claviger*] and cook, in bread baked 3 quarters 4 bushels wheat. Also in ale malt 2 quarter 2 bushels barley malt. In 76<sup>60</sup> gallons ale bought besides [*preter*] malt brewed 9s 6d, <sup>7s 6d</sup> price of a gallon 1½d. In 1 bushel oatmeal bought 18d. <sup>16d</sup> In meat – beef, pork and mutton – bought 12s 4d. <sup>9s 8d</sup> In salted fish bought and mackerel 8s 4d. <sup>5s 4d</sup> In cheese, butter and milk bought 6s 6d. <sup>5s</sup> In 3lb wax bought for boonworks at Estbury and manor of Morden 18d. In 3lb of candles bought 6d. ~~In gratuities given to various men of the vill [*villat*] viz at Estbury 3s, at the court of the hospital of Morden [*eur* *hospital de Mordone*] 12d. Also manor of <sup>w</sup>estbery 8d. In 1 bushel salt bought 8d. <sup>6d</sup> In 6 dishes [*diss*] bought, 4 dishes [*paraps*], 4 saucers and 2 bowls [*ciphis*] bought 10d. In horseshoes bought with fitting said shoes nothing here. In clouts bought with spike-nails [*pikes*] nothing here. In grease bought for greasing carts 6d. <sup>4d</sup> In 1 cart hired for 4 days in harvest 4s.~~ Sum 36s 8d.\*

### **Stipends**

Also in stipend of 1 horseman 6s 8d. <sup>5s</sup> In stipend of 2<sup>1</sup> tithe collector this year 6s. <sup>3s</sup> In stipend of 1 carter with cart and 3 horses for the whole of harvest together with horseshoes and clouts provided at his own expense 16s. In stipend of 1 pitcher 3s. In stipend of 1 stacker both for the corn of the manor and for the rectory 4s. In stipend of 1 cellarer [*claviger*] and cook 4s. <sup>3s 4d</sup> ~~In food allowance [*potur*] for the said 7<sup>6</sup> men in harvest for 7<sup>5</sup> weeks this year 4s 1d, each of them 7d. Also in 7<sup>6</sup> pairs of gloves [*cirotec*] bought for the said servants 21d. <sup>12d</sup> In stipend of Robert ate Rith for custody of the Rectory at the same place for the year 13s 4d.~~ Sum 35s 4d.
