**Farm**For farm of the manor of Morden leased to Ralph atte Rithe for the year for a term of 7 years this year 6<sup>th</sup> £14.

Sum £14. approved

**Profits of court**For the Court with View held at the same place Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July, 15s 6d.

Sum 15s 6d. approved

**Sale of stock**

For 4 capons of ‘head-penny’/chevage sold 16d, price per head 4d.

Sum 16d.

**Sum total of receipts with arrears £31 11s 10d.****approved****Rents Resolute**

In rent resolute of Thomas Kynwardeslee for the year, 4 terms, 4s.

Sum 4s.

**Cash Deliveries**Delivered to brother John Burwell bailiff of Westminster, both in full payment [*persolutoem*] of arrears and for part of his farm this year by 1 tally, £12 16s 10d .

£12 16s 10d.

**Sum of all payments and deliveries £13 10d. And so he owes £18 11s.***Quietus* Which arrears, however, will be charged in his account next following. And so he is quit in respect of this.**Note:** That John Gildon owes to the same Ralph 8s 2d.**Value this year      £14 12s 10d.**

**DORSE**

<b>Wheat</b>	Of the remaining, 12 quarters. And there remain 12 quarters wheat in the hands of Ralph atte Rithe farmer of the same place by indenture.
<b>Peas</b>	Of the remaining, 8 quarters. And there remain 8 quarters peas in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.
<b>Barley</b>	Of the remaining, 18 quarters. And there remain 18 quarters barley in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.
<b>Oats</b>	Of the remaining, 25 quarters. And there remain 25 quarters oats in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.

**LIVESTOCK ACCOUNT**

<b>Carthorses</b>	Of the remaining, 2. And there remain 2 carthorses in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.
<b>Oxen</b>	Of the remaining, 8. And there remain 8 oxen in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.
<b>Geese</b>	Of the remaining, 7, of which 1 gander and 4 breeding females. And there remain 7 geese, of which 1 gander and 4 breeding females, in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.
<b>Capons</b>	Of head-penny/chevage of William Edward and John atte Hedg' the lord's serfs as appears by roll of court, 4. Sum 4. And sold as within. And it balances.
<b>Cocks and hens</b>	Of the remaining, 1 cock and 12 hens. And there remain 1 cock and 12 hens in the hands of the aforesaid farmer. approved.
<b>Hurdles for the fold</b>	Of the remaining, 68. And there remain 68 hurdles for the fold in the hands of the aforesaid farmer.
<b>Morden</b>	<b>Account for the same place for the 21<sup>st</sup> year of the reign of King Richard II.</b>
